- 1. The hearing to consider the above


shall be held on October 3, 1995, at 9:30 o'clock a m. in the

section 1329, moves the court for an order suspending the payments
of the Debtor under the plan and in support thereof, would show:


1. That the Debtor, Claudester Taylor, is unemployed and has
