I, Bobbie Cannon, Secretary/Treasurer of Cannon Brothers Air Conditioning & Heating, Inc., a corporation organized and doing business under the laws of the State of Tennessee and licensed to do business in the State of Mississippi, with offices located at 5492 Old Highway 78, Memphis, Tennessee 38118, make the following sworn statement in claim of lien under Section 85-7-131 of the Mississippi Code Annotated.

Cannon Brothers Air Conditioning & Heating, Inc., herewith claims a mechanic's and materialmen's lien for work, labor and materials as hereinafter set out, rendered, furnished and delivered to Patrick Olmstead, whose offices are located at 3012 Shade Tree Cove, Bartlett, Tennessee 38134, for the improvement of certain premises owned by Michael A. and Lucretia A. Ward Norwood, in DeSoto County, Mississippi, municipally known as 14693 Strickland Road, Byhalia, Mississippi 38611, more specifically described as follows:

One acre, more or less, and the improvements thereon in the northeast corner of that certain 101-acre tract of land in the east 1/2 of Section 16, Township 3, Range 5, located in the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, owned formerly by Effie I. Culver, said one-acre tract being known as the Cathey School Grounds and being the same property described of record in Deed Book 280, Page 98, in the office of the Chancery Court Clerk's Office in DeSoto County, Mississippi.

Said work, labor and materials were rendered, furnished and delivered to Patrick Olmstead. During that period of time the subcontractor, Cannon Brothers Air Conditioning & Heating, Inc., was engaged in improvement of the aforesaid property pursuant to a contract with Patrick Olmstead; said work, labor and materials were rendered and furnished for the purpose of being used by the contractor for improving the property.

Work, labor and materials rendered, furnished and delivered to Patrick Olmstead, consists of the following types: installation of ductwork. The total value of the work, labor and materials rendered, furnished, delivered and unpaid is \$2,200.00, plus interest.

All the aforesaid work, labor and materials furnished by Cannon Brothers Air Conditioning & Heating, Inc., were used in and about the improvement of the aforesaid real estate for the owner thereof. This Notice of Lien has been filed within the time required according to the laws of the State of Mississippi, and that the claimant will take all legal steps to enforce lien as required by law.

The amount justly due and owing for work, labor and materials rendered, furnished, delivered and unpaid, after allowing all just credits and deductions is the sum of \$2,200.00, plus interest; all of which is due and unpaid.

Now comes Cannon Brothers Air Conditioning & Heating, Inc., and claims the lien upon the aforesaid property, improvements in buildings and thereon for \$2,200.00, plus interest, according to the statutes and laws providing mechanic's and materialmen's lien in this state.
