



Lot 26, Phase II, Section "B", Wesson Heights, located in Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 6 West, Desoto County, Mississippi, as recorded in Plat Book 99, Pages 17-19, in the Office of the Chancery Court of Desoto County, Mississippi.

(the "Project").

The construction materials rendered, furnished and delivered to the Owner included, without limitation, framing lumber for use in the improvement of the Project owned by the Owner. Said construction materials were rendered, furnished and delivered to and for the benefit of the Owner pursuant to a contract dated October 3, 2000, and last provided on or about August 26, 2008. Said materials were rendered, furnished and delivered for the purpose of improving the real property described hereinabove and owned by the Owner.

All of the aforesaid construction materials were furnished by Thrifty and used in and about the improvement of the afore-described real property for the Owner thereof. This Notice of Lien Claim has been filed within the time required according to the laws of the State of Mississippi, and the claimant will take all legal steps to enforce its lien as required by law.

The total amount justly due and owing for construction materials furnished to and delivered to the property, after allowing all just credits and deductions, is the sum of Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Six Dollars and Eighty-Six cents (\$12,306.865), all of which remains due and unpaid.

Now comes Thrifty and claims a lien upon the aforesaid real property, including the improvements, buildings and structures thereon for \$12,306.86, plus interest, attorney's fees and recording fees for filing of this lien, according to the statutes and laws providing mechanics' and materialmen's liens in this State.
