Whereas, the lien of the United States, listed above, for said tax has attached to certain property described as: The north 103.3 acres of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 6 West; and 3.0 acres, more or less, in the southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 6 West, described as: Beginning 11.66 chains south of the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of said Section 33 (which point is the northeast corner of the tract owned by T.H. Collins), thence west with the north line of the Collins tract and the Baptist Church lot to the east right of way of State Highway 305, thence northeasterly with the east right of way line of said highway to the north line of the southeast quarter of Section 33, thence east to point of beginning, Less and except 1.8 acres conveyed by P.M. Ross and wife, to DeSoto County by deed recorded in Deed Book 33, page 428.

The above description of this property is not by survey and includes all the land conveyed to Alfred Holland and wife, Mittie J. Holland by deed of date April 1, 1965, and recorded in Book 61, page 457; and further the same land described in that certain Deed



Whereas, the District Director of Internal Revenue has determined that the value of the interest of the United States in the foregoing property, under and by virtue of its aforesaid tax lien, amounts to the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Fourteen and 32/100 dollars (\$ 6,514.32 ) and has authorized the issuance, under the provisions of section 6325(b)(2)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code, of a certificate discharging the above-described property from the tax lien of the United States upon the payment of the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Fourteen and 32/100 dollars (\$ 6,514.32 ) to be applied in part satisfaction of the liability in respect of the tax hereinbefore stated which sum has been paid to be so applied, and the receipt of which sum by me is hereby acknowledged; Robert B. Douthitt

Now, therefore, this instrument witnesseth, that I, Robert B. Douthitt, District Director of Internal Revenue at Jackson, Mississippi, charged by law with the duty of collecting and enforcing the collection of internal revenue taxes due the United States, and charged with the assessment hereinbefore stated, do, pursuant to the provisions of section 6325(b)(2)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code, discharge the property heretofore described from the aforesaid tax lien, saving and reserving, however, the force and effect of said tax lien against and upon all other property or rights to property to which said lien is attached, wheresoever situated.
