Notice is hereby given of a lien against the property of the defendant named below. Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 3613(a), a fine imposed pursuant to the provisions of subchapter C of chapter 227 is a lien in favor of the United States upon all property belonging to the person fined. Pursuant to § 3613(d) a notice of lien shall be considered a notice of lien for taxes for the purposes of any state of local law providing for the filing of a tax lien. The lien arises at the time of the entry of judgment and continues until the liability is satisfied, remitted, set aside, or becomes unenforceable. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3663(h)(1)(A), restitution imposed as part of the defendant's sentence is a lien in the same manner and to the same extent as a fine.
