

LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Margeret C. This Power of Attorney shall be binding upon my heirs, executor and estate, and my personal representatives. This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by the subsequent disability or incompetence of the undersigned.

the above property is fully completed and all funds dispersed and documents delivered and recorded.
