

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to inform you that Leonard Casper, a soldier in this unit of the Mississippi National Guard has been called to active duty for possible deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, or homeland defense.

The mobilization for the possible deployment will occur on AUGUST 12, 2004, and will continue for up to 24 months at the direction of the President.

Most soldiers are not receiving individual orders that reflect that they are being mobilized. Instead the orders are being issued to military units in which the soldiers serve. It is for that reason that as commander of one of the mobilized units, I have prepared this official notice of this soldier's call to duty.

The soldier by his mobilization gains various rights under state and federal statutes. We appreciate your understanding of the special needs that arise for soldiers as mobilization takes them away from their usual employment and places of residence. The soldier should be providing to you an explanation prepared by the Mississippi National Guard of the applicable rights.
