

SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

THIS IS A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY PREPARED AND EXECUTED PURSUANT TO TITLE 10, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 1044B, BY A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE LEGAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE MILITARY SERVICES. FEDERAL LAW EXEMPTS A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY FROM ANY REQUIREMENT OF FORM, SUBSTANCE, FORMALITY OR RECORDING THAT IS PROVIDED FOR POWERS OF ATTORNEY BY THE LAW OF ANY STATE, COMMONWEALTH, TERRITORY, DISTRICT, OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES. FEDERAL LAW SPECIFIES THAT A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY SHALL BE GIVEN THE SAME LEGAL EFFECT AS A POWER OF ATTORNEY PREPARED AND EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE JURISDICTION WHERE IT IS PRESENTED.

KNOW ALL PERSONS, that I, AMY R. SHILLINGSBURG, a legal resident of MARYLAND and presently residing at PSC 45 BOX 1672 RAF Menwith Hill APO AE 09468, desiring to execute a SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY, do hereby appoint Tanya R. Segars whose address is Olive Branch, MS, as my Attorney-in-Fact to act as follows, GRANTING unto my said Attorney full power to:

To purchase in my name and for my use the below-described real property in the town of Olive Branch, County of Desoto, state of MS located at 5694 Hunter's Chase Dr South Haven, MS 38672 and being legally described as: Lot #146 Deerchase, Desoto County South Haven MS, and for that purpose to make indorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and deliver any application forms, documents, instruments, or paper necessary or convenient to enter into both a contract and mortgage or deed of trust upon said real estate for such price, at such rate of interest and upon such terms as she shall deem best, but the loan will not exceed \$ 120,000.00 and will be repaid over a period not to exceed 30 years.

Giving and granting individually unto said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and any act, deed, matter and thing whatsoever in and about any of the specified particulars mentioned in the paragraph immediately above, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might and could do in my own person if personally present; and in addition thereto, I do hereby ratify and confirm each of the acts of my aforesaid attorney lawfully done pursuant to the authority herein above conferred.

TERMINATION: This Power of Attorney shall become null and void the 13th day of February, 2006 unless I should become incapacitated; in that case, it shall remain in effect until revoked by me.


Notwithstanding my insertion of a specific expiration date herein, if on the above specified expiration date I shall be, or have been, carried in a military status of "missing," "missing-in-action," or "prisoner of war," then this power of attorney shall automatically remain valid and in full effect until sixty (60) days after I have returned to United States Military control following termination of such status.
