

**DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES**

I, BETTY G. KIRK, an adult resident citizen of Shelby County, Tennessee, do by these presents, hereby nominate and appoint as my Agent and Attorney in Fact, Brennan G. Kirk, with full power and authority to act for, in my stead, and in my behalf, as follows:

(1) To have broad and discretionary powers in handling my business affairs, including the receipt and deposit of monies due to me from rents, interest, social security, retirement payments, proceeds from insurance policies, bonds, dividends, or other investments that I might have.

(2) To sign and execute all financial or other legal documents for and on my behalf, including, but not limited to, endorsement of checks, drafts or other securities and deposit of all proceeds and receipts from all investments and income in my name in any banking institution in the United States, including, but not limited to, the State of Mississippi and the State of Tennessee.

(3) To write, sign, execute, and draw checks or drafts on my account in any bank in the United States, including, but not limited to, the State of Mississippi and the State of Tennessee.

(4) To enter into my lock box at any time and to deposit and take therefrom any papers or valuables which I might have.

(5) To manage any real estate which I might own in the State of Mississippi or any other state, including the authority to sell, mortgage, or otherwise deal with said real estate and to expend required monies for the payment of insurance and taxes thereon.

(6) To sign, execute, and deliver for and on my behalf any instrument relating to any real estate or personal property which I might own, including, but not limited to, deeds,

mortgages, homestead exemption forms, stocks, and bills of sale, as fully and completely as if same were signed, executed, and delivered by me personally.

(7) To sell, transfer, and assign any stocks, bonds, or other securities that I might own and to execute all necessary documents in order to effectuate such transfers.

(8) This power of attorney shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incompetency, it being my specific intent that the authority conferred by this instrument shall be exercisable by my Agent and Attorney in Fact, notwithstanding my subsequent disability or incompetency, and all acts done by my said Agent and Attorney in Fact, pursuant to this power of attorney, during any period of disability or incompetency, shall have the same affect and inure to the benefit of and bind me, my devisees, legatees and personal representatives, as if I were competent and not disabled.


