This is a **MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY** prepared pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1044b and executed by a person authorized to receive legal assistance from the military services. Federal law exempts this power of attorney from any requirement of form, substance, formality, or recording that is prescribed for powers of attorney under the law of a State, the District of Columbia, or a territory, Commonwealth, or possession of the United States. Federal law specifies that this power of attorney shall be given the same legal effect as a power of attorney prepared and executed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction where it is presented.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

That I, TROY L. GORDON, a legal resident of the State of MISSISSIPPI, have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint RASHONDA R. GORDON as my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, giving and granting to my attorney-in-fact full authority and power to:

FURTHER, I do authorize my attorney-in-fact to perform every act and thing whatsoever that is necessary or appropriate to accomplish the purposes for which this Power of Attorney is granted, as fully and effectually as I could if I were present; and;

I HEREBY RATIFY all that my attorney-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this document;

SIGN MY NAME ON A RETAIL INSTALLMENT CONTRACT AND SECURITY AGREEMENT WITH PHYICIANS MARKETING GROUP IN ORDER TO OBTAIN COSMETIC SURGERY

PROVIDED, however, that all business transacted hereunder for me or for my account shall be transacted in my name and that all endorsements and instruments executed by my attorney-in-fact for the purpose of carrying out the foregoing powers shall contain my name followed by that of my attorney-in-fact and the designation "attorney-in-fact."

This power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until my death, the death of my attorney-in-fact, I revoke it, or until

10 November 2007, whichever occurs first.



PROVIDED, however, that if the foregoing paragraph is crossed-out, than this Power of Attorney shall expire upon the date of the expiry stated above under Title 50 Appendix, United States Code, Section 591b.


