



EXHIBIT A

TRUSTEE'S POWERS

The Trustee shall have the following powers and discretions in connection with the administration of the trusts described in this Agreement:

1. Enter upon and take possession of the Trust Estate;
2. Collect the income and profits therefrom, and to invest and reinvest the trust property in real, personal or mixed assets in accordance with its judgment, not being limited by any present or future investment law or any "prudent man" investment rule;
3. Retain all property in the form in which the same shall be received or acquired by it without liability for any loss that may be incurred thereby, and without regard to the proportion that any one asset or class of assets may bear to the whole;
4. Allocate between income and principal all receipts and disbursements in accordance with sound trust accounting principles;
5. In addition the Trustee shall have all of the powers contained in Nevada Revised Statutes 163.265 to 163.410 inclusive, and any powers and authorities necessary or desirable to effectuate any powers expressly granted herein to the Trustee.

The Trustee shall not need the approval or license of any party or court to exercise any of the foregoing powers.
