SUBSTITUTED TRUSTEES DEED

WHEREAS, on December 30, 1996, Butch Bible, Jr. and wife, Pamela D. Bible, executed a Deed of Trust to Thomas F. Baker, IV, Trustee for the benefit of FT Mortgage Companies d/b/a First Tennessee Mortgage Company, Inc., which Deed of Trust is filed for record in Book 878 at Page 418, and corrected in Book 2110 at Page 525 in the office of the Chancery Clerk of DeSoto County at Hernando, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, said Deed of Trust was subsequently assigned to Midfirst Bank by instrument dated May 5, 2003 and recorded in Book 1747 at Page 433, and by correction instrument dated January 18, 2005 recorded in Book 2146 at Page 524 of the aforesaid records; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by the aforesaid Deed of Trust and in strict accordance therewith, Midfirst Bank appointed and substituted J. Gary Massey as Trustee therein in the place and stead of the trustee named in said Deed of Trust or subsequently substituted therein by Substitution of Trustee dated December 17, 2003, and duly filed for record in the office of the aforesaid Chancery Clerk in Book 1892 at Page 373, and rerecorded in Book 2146 at Page 526 prior to the first publication and posting of the notice of sale; and

WHEREAS, default having been made in the terms and conditions of said Deed of Trust, which default continued for a period of time necessary for the holder thereof to declare the entire indebtedness, together with attorney's fees, expenses and costs, immediately due and payable, as was its option so to do under the terms of said Deed of Trust, and default having been made in payment of said amount and the Substituted Trustee having been requested and directed by Midfirst Bank to foreclose under the terms of said Deed of Trust, I did on February 25, 2005, during legal hours, being between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., at the East Front door of the County Courthouse of DeSoto County, Hernando, Mississippi, in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Trust and the laws of the State of Mississippi, offer for sale at public auction and sell to the highest and best bidder for cash the following described land and property lying and being situated in DeSoto County, Mississippi, being more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Lot 624, Section D, Twin Lakes Subdivision, in Section 6, Township 2 South, Range 8 West, DeSoto County, Mississippi, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 18, Pages 32-33, in the office of the Chancery Clerk of DeSoto County, Mississippi.

Said property was sold after strictly complying with all the terms and conditions of said Deed of Trust and the statutes made and provided in such cases. A notice of time, place and terms of said sale, together with a description of the property to be sold, was given by publication in the DeSoto County Times, a newspaper published in DeSoto County, Mississippi for three consecutive weeks preceding the date of sale. At said Sale, Midfirst Bank bid for said property in the amount of \$52,796.16, which being the highest and best bid, the same was then and there struck off to Midfirst Bank and it was declared the purchaser thereof.

WHEREAS, Midfirst Bank has requested transfer and assignment of its bid to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America and has authorized the undersigned to convey the property described above to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America; and the undersigned, by execution of this instrument, does hereby transfer and assign all right, title and interest of Midfirst Bank as the highest and best bidder to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America pursuant to authority granted to the undersigned in the aforementioned Substitution of Trustee.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the full payment of the purchase price, I, the undersigned Substituted Trustee, do hereby sell and convey unto the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America the land and property herein described. I convey only such title as is vested in me as Substituted Trustee.




